Create a Zoom Account

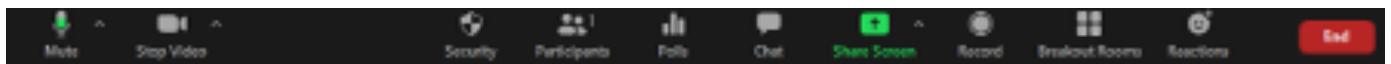
- In order to join, you must create a free Zoom Account (if you do not already have one).
